**Adaptive Music Ed and Intro to Music Therapy for Special Needs presentation and free workshop
with Zetta Music Therapy, hosted by SixTwelve and the Music Moves Mountains Foundation 4.18.15**

Oklahoma City, OK -- On Saturday, April 18th, a presentation by Zetta Music Therapy on how to incorporate adaptive techniques into music education, as well as an introduction to the medical practice of music therapy, will be offered at 10am for those working with the special needs community such as music educators, special education teachers, therapists, and parents. Following the presentation, a free community music workshop for children with special needs will take place at 1pm offering a hands-on experience with instruments and an opportunity for families to network with the music therapists. Both events will take place at SixTwelve, a new educational and creative space in the Paseo District serving the community, located at 612 NW 29th St., OKC, OK 73103, PH (405) 208-8291. A suggested tax-deductible donation of \$10 / \$5 for students will be accepted for the morning presentation which will benefit the Music Moves Mountains Foundation's efforts to bring more awareness and opportunity to those in need of music therapy and education. Refreshments will be provided.

Board-certified music therapists and music educators Amber Loomis, MME, MT-BC and Zach Williams, MA, MT-BC of Zetta Music Therapy both have experience and focus on those affected by developmental disorders including Autism Spectrum Disorders, as well as other behavioral and neurological challenges. The Music Moves Mountains Foundation was launched in 2012 in response to the lack of state support and resources in the community for music therapy, music education and related services, especially for the underserved and special needs populations.
